AEEP Milestones



2007: Launch of the AEEP by African and European Heads of State at the AU-EU Summit in Lisbon.



2007-2019: Agenda setting and international progress through high-level stakeholder meetings that place energy at the top of the international development agenda.



2019-2022: Towards SDG7 with new African-European ties and tools to accelerate energy sector investments.



2023-2025: Bi-continental action for a just energy transition in a partnership of equals.



2026: Implementation of a joint vision embedded in key initiatives such as AfSEM, CMP and AEGER.

AEEP Activity Areas



To carry out its mandate, the AEEP supports African and European actors to implement key initiatives and actions through:

Integrated dialogue

An integrated dialogue in a partnership of equals between Africa and Europe that supports the implementation of bicontinental joint actions and the realisation of a just energy transition in Africa.

Knowledge and Visibility

Knowledge products for a just energy transition inform the dialogue and promote bicontinental action (including the Africa-EU Green Energy Initiative).

Catalysing Implementation

Continental and regional African institutions supported by the AEEP Secretariat are better positioned to implement joint African-European initiatives.



Integrated Dialogue

- High-level dialogues, including the AEEP Forum, bring together key actors from the public and private sector and civil society, to showcase and shape joint action.
- Specific dialogues, such as the AEEP Energy Talks webinar series, for exchange on key aspects of the African energy transition and to accelerate the implementation of key initiatives.
- Coordination and alignment formats to facilitate information flow and coordination among the main European and African political stakeholders, including the AEEP Steering Group.



Knowledge and Visibility

- Flagship annual report on 'European financial Flows on SDG7 to Africa'.
- Analytical papers and think pieces on key aspects of African and European energy transitions.
- Regular updates on energy achievements and developments on both continents.







Catalysing Implementation

- Capacitating African institutions (AUC and AUDA NEPAD) to facilitate the implementation of the AfSEM, the CMP, and other joint AU-EU flagship initiatives.
- Facilitate ongoing AU-EU dialogue on AEGEI
- Positioning joint bi-continental priorities within international fora such as the UN climate conferences and G20 meetings.
